God has greatly blessed us over these past two months with wonderful opportunities to share His work in Peru, to share the good news of salvation with several people, and to pray with several children regarding salvation decisions. We praise Him for His continued provision, protection, and guidance.

During May and June, we had meetings with 10 new churches, visited 1 of our supporting churches and 1 other church we visited earlier this year, helped with 2 supporting churches VBS programs, and ministered at Camp Chetek as missionary speakers. We have had a full schedule, yet we are refreshed and encouraged to continue.

One of the biggest blessings during these 2 months was the opportunity to lead our son, Jack, to the Lord. God has been working in his heart for some time, and one of the messages at Camp Chetek gave us a good opportunity to remind him of his need. He is excited to be a part of God's family now. Will you pray with us that as he continues to grow he will understand the decision he made and will be faithful in following Christ?

We had several opportunities during the 2 weeks of VBS to share the Good News of salvation with several boys and girls. During our week at Camp Chetek, several of the campers and counselors expressed a desire to pursue missionary work. Will you pray that God will continue to work in their hearts? Will you pray that God will continue to raise up laborers for His work in Peru and around the world?

We continue to receive positive reports about our ministry and believe that we are at about 15% of our support now. Will you pray for the churches we have visited as they consider supporting us? We are praying that God will help us to be at 40% of our support by January 2011.

Caleb and his dad leave for Peru on July 8. Caleb's dad will preach at a pastor's conference in Lima, Caleb will teach in 2 of our seminaries in Peru, and they will both have several opportunities to preach in churches there. Will you pray that God will keep them safe, give them success in their ministry opportunities, and give them opportunities to encourage our coworkers while they are there?

We are continuing to fill our schedule for September 2010 and beyond. Will you pray that God will give us a full schedule? We desire to be out every Sunday, sharing God's work in Peru with our North American churches.

Thank you so much for your faithful prayers. We cannot possibly accomplish God's work without your help.
