Thank you for your faithful prayers for us as we have ventured out onto fulltime deputation. We have seen God clearly direct and bless, and we are excited about what He has in store for us in the coming weeks and months.

Deputation News

We have had a very profitable first 2 months of fulltime deputation ministry. We had meetings with 6 churches in September and October:

- Calvary Baptist Church in Watertown, WI
- Fellowship Baptist Church in Watertown, WI

Besides ministry in the churches, we had the privilege of participating in our home church's Missions Conference at the end of September. We presented Peru and missions each day in the Christian School to different groups of students. Caleb also had the opportunity to preach in Missions Chapel at Maranatha Baptist Bible College in October. We continue to pray that God will use the time we spent at in these chapel and classroom times to encourage the students to consider their part in missions.

Future Plans

We look forward to meetings with nine churches in November and December. We continue to pray that God will burden others with ministry in Peru as we present His ministry in churches.

We have filled our calendar for the most part until the end of June 2010, and all but two of these meetings are in Wisconsin. We are filling our calendar beyond that, and praying for God's wisdom regarding future meetings. Caleb has been asked to teach *Theology of Missions* to college sophomores next semester at Maranatha. We are excited for the opportunity he has to participate in this ministry.

- Financial support: we received word that First Baptist Church in Hartford, WI, (Ecko's home church) has taken us on for support. We anticipate two families doing the same in the next few weeks. This should bring our support level to 10%.

Prayer Requests

- Financial Support: we are praying that God will provide 40 to 50% of our support from churches and individuals in Wisconsin. Pray with us that God will meet and even exceed this goal.
- Language Training: we have begun language training under the tutelage of Dr. Manuel and Pam Morales, Spanish professors at Maranatha. They have committed to helping us achieve fluency before we leave for Peru. Pray that we will dedicate the necessary time to becoming fluent.

Thank you for faithfully praying for us. We look forward to what God has in store for us and will continue to keep you updated with our progress.
